<p>Star Wars Tabletop Club</p> <p>Tabletop gaming increases critical thinking skills, socialization, patience, creativity, and cooperation amongst players. Because so much of Star Wars is based on real-world materials and technological advancements, students will be able to apply real-world applications to their game. They will create their own original characters then strategize together as they play through various campaigns. Campaigns will be led by the instructor and will include traps, enemies, and non-player allies.
